Life Stage

Congratulations on your kitten! Your kitten is in the pediatric or juvenile stage of life and needs several boosters to jump start immunity and provide protection before becoming an adult.

Life Style

Your kitten is curious and will be traveling to UVH several times this year for boosters. It is very important to provide a great foundation for immunity. After the last set of boosters, when your kitten is about 1 year of age, your visits will decrease to every 6 months and we can begin to select what vaccinations your cats needs.
